2009 ASCE Transportation Scholarship Award

CRITERIA

ELIGIBILITY

1. Any Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior level, ASCE Student Member in good standing at one of the local San Diego universities may apply for this scholarship. Scholarship will be awarded to a student pursuing a career in the field of Transportation.
2. Scholarship funds may be applied only for tuition and material expenses during the Freshman, Sophomore, Junior and Senior years of formal undergraduate civil engineering education in an accredited educational institution within the San Diego local section boundaries and must be enrolled in the institution for the Fall 2008 semester/quarter.
3. Applicants must have a minimum of a 2.5 overall grade point average.

APPLICATION

1. The attached application should be completed, three (3) copies of which should be submitted by **March 20, 2009**. Awards will be given at the **April 2009** ASCE Transportation Group Meeting. Please submit your application to:

2. Application package must include (at a minimum): (1) a filled out scholarship application form, (2) proof of enrollment at the college/university, (3) proof of ASCE Student Membership, and an (4) Unofficial Transcript.

SELECTION

1. The ASCE Transportation Group Board will appoint the Scholarship Committee headed up by the current Scholarship Chair.
2. All applications will be reviewed by the appointed Scholarship Committee, who will submit their recommendation to the ASCE Transportation Group Board for approval.
3. The Scholarship Committee may recommend more than one recipient, or may recommend that no award be made in a particular year, if no meritorious applications are received.
4. Selection is based on appraisal of applicants' needs, educational plans, academic performance, potential for development, leadership, ASCE activities and other student activities.

AWARDS

1. The total sum for awards available will be determined annually by the ASCE Transportation Group Board, based on earnings available from corporate sponsorship, donations and any other funding authorized by the ASCE Transportation Group Board.
2. Recipients will be notified and the official presentation will be made at the ASCE Transportation Group's December Meeting.
